A bitter bankside rivalry resolved by the discovery of a shocking secret; a mysterious creature that seems to lurk at the bottom of a Welsh garden pond; the trail camera set for poachers that captures erotic scenes by moonlight... These tantalising tales explore the unexpected side of fishing, particularly after dark when the river's enchantment fades into the shadows.

Some are loosely based on the author's angling experiences while others have 'popped up like bubbles from below a river's surface, their source unknown'.

This collection of sparkling fishing stories is set in Britain and further afield. The Márna Hours won third place in the 2021 Ruritania Prize for original short fiction from Central and Eastern Europe.
